The Board of Trustees has many responsibilities and duties, including hiring the Superintendent, making decisions on school property, approving contracts, authorizing bids and expenditures, approving school budgets, overseeing curriculum, and approving issues related to personnel.

School boards are charged with decisions that impact what students learn, how students are taught, how learning is measured, how teachers are supported with professional development, how funds are focused on District priorities, and how effectively the community is engaged with student learning.
